ONLINE SERVICE

Enjoy a full, prerecorded service from home as you have been doing. The sermon will be recorded on Sunday morning and made available online a couple of days later; many families will likely choose to use this resource on a one-week delay from the in-person service.

FIRST SERVICE, SUNDAY 9:00AM MODIFIED SERVICE

This is open to the general public for anyone **completely symptom free**. **RSVPs are required** and social distancing is practiced & accommodated while inside the building. This **First Service** will begin inside the chapel (doors open 8:50 AM) and will consist of a time of prayer, scripture reading, time of reflection during special music, and a live sermon. After the sermon, First Service attendees will join together with the arriving Second Service attendees outside (weather permitting) for a time of praise & worship in the parking lot. Folding chairs will be available for those in need of them. The time of praise & worship will be followed by a time of visiting and fellowship.

SECOND SERVICE, SUNDAY 9:50AM MODIFIED SERVICE

This is open to the general public for anyone **completely symptom free**. **RSVPs are required** and social distancing is practiced & accommodated while inside the building. This **Second Service** officially begins in the parking lot when the First Service attendees join together for a time of praise and worship (folding chairs will be available for those who would like them) then visiting & fellowship. After the visiting time, Second Service attendees will head into the chapel and be seated for a time of prayer, scripture reading, time of reflection during special music, and a live sermon.

WHAT TO EXPECT

UPON ARRIVAL:

- Doors will open at a specific time and folks waiting to enter are welcome to visit in the parking lot while respecting individual comfort levels of social distancing
- Social distancing will be observed inside the building and has been accommodated for with one-way walk paths, 6 feet apart seating in the chapel, and no-touch entry/exit of the building.

ONCE INSIDE:

- Please follow all traffic-flow paths that are marked within the church and observe social distancing of 6 feet or more
- Please make your way to the sanctuary; do not linger in the foyer and do not enter rooms marked "closed".
- We ask that you keep all family members together at all times including children; even when in the presence of another family with whom you're comfortable while indoors

FOR THE SERVICE:

- The sanctuary will contain groups of 2-9 chairs spaced at least 6 feet apart.
- Please choose the smallest group of chairs that suits the size of your household and remain there for the remainder of your time with us. If your family requires more than 6 chairs, an usher can assist you.
- If you need to use the restroom, please follow the traffic-flow path direction out through the parking lot and back into the building until you reach the bathroom door. Cleaning supplies will be available in each restroom as needed for safety/sanitation before and/or after use.
- When concluded, please allow space and timing for everyone to dismiss without gathering at the exit

WHAT WE'RE DOING TO PROTECT OUR FAMILY

- Monitoring CDC and WI DHS recommendations
- Using COVID-19 appropriate cleaning supplies as directed
- Sanitizing frequently touched surfaces before/after building usage
- Providing hand sanitizer and cleaning supplies to those in the building to utilize as needed
- Suspending air-flow HVAC systems (heat, air conditioning) while the building is in use for corporate gatherings to reduce the spread of air-borne particles
- Providing social distancing procedures for all to use while in the building (places to sit, walking paths, etc.)
- Sectioning off the building to help reduce cross-contamination between small group and corporate gathering uses
- Reducing the spaces used to maximize cleaning and containment
- Refusing admittance to anyone who shows signs or symptoms of illness into the building
- Strictly enforcing social distancing guidelines within the building
- Restricting the number of people in the building (via RSVPs for corporate gatherings) to avoid overcrowding (A wait list will be used in the event of maximum capacity.)
